

## Pants & Shirts

### Notes:

The pants pattern is the same, front to back, so no need to keep track of which is where.

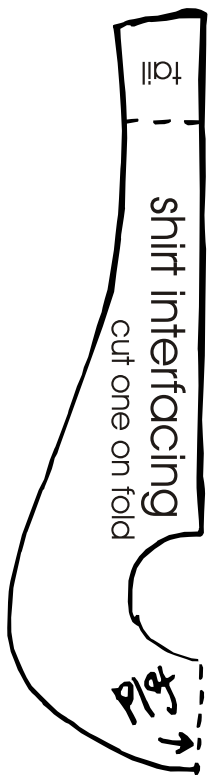
The shirt has some options depending on your level of patience!

The collar is completely optional, and be warned, it is very tedious to do, but SO cute if you have the patience for it!

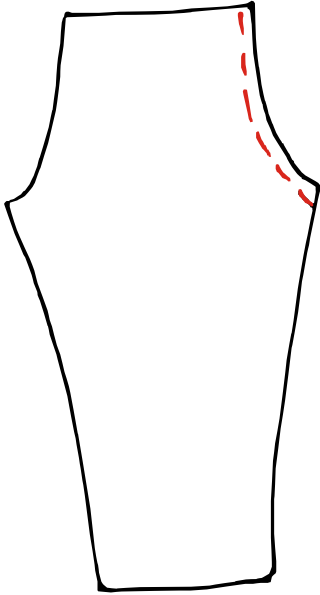
Same goes for the shirt tails...if you have the patience to hem the curves nicely, it comes out very cute...if you don't feel like it, then cut it off at the dotted lines and have a very nice straight hemmed shirt!

The choices are yours! Have fun with it!

Also note, this shirt pattern is not the best for striped fabrics, as the sleeves are not separate. This means the stripes would go horizontally on the body and vertically on the sleeves and looks odd. Just so you know!



# Pants Instructions



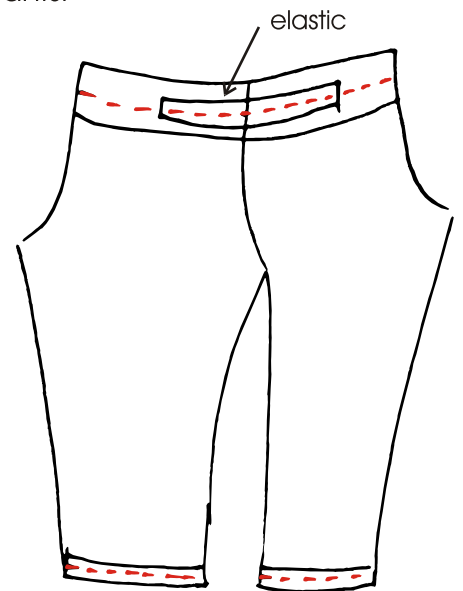
With right sides together, sew along back seam.

Turn up hems and turn down waistband, and press.

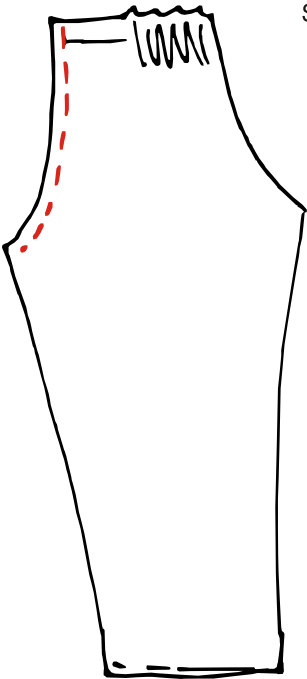
Hem the bottoms of the pant legs.

Stitch along the waistline, adding elastic as indicated, stretching as you go.

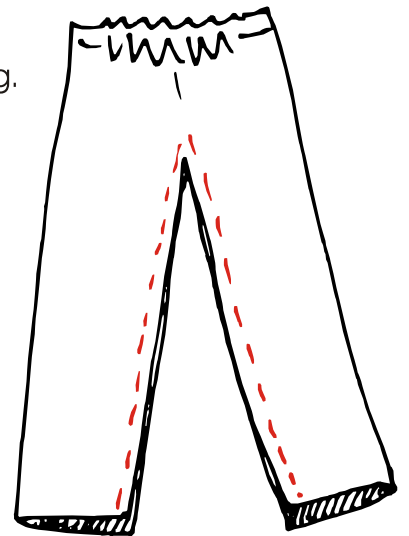
This will be the back of the pants.



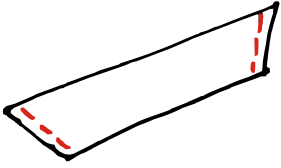
Keeping right sides together, stitch up the front seam.



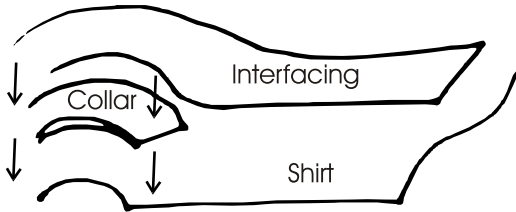
Stitch up the inseam and down the other leg. Turn right side out, press and you're done!



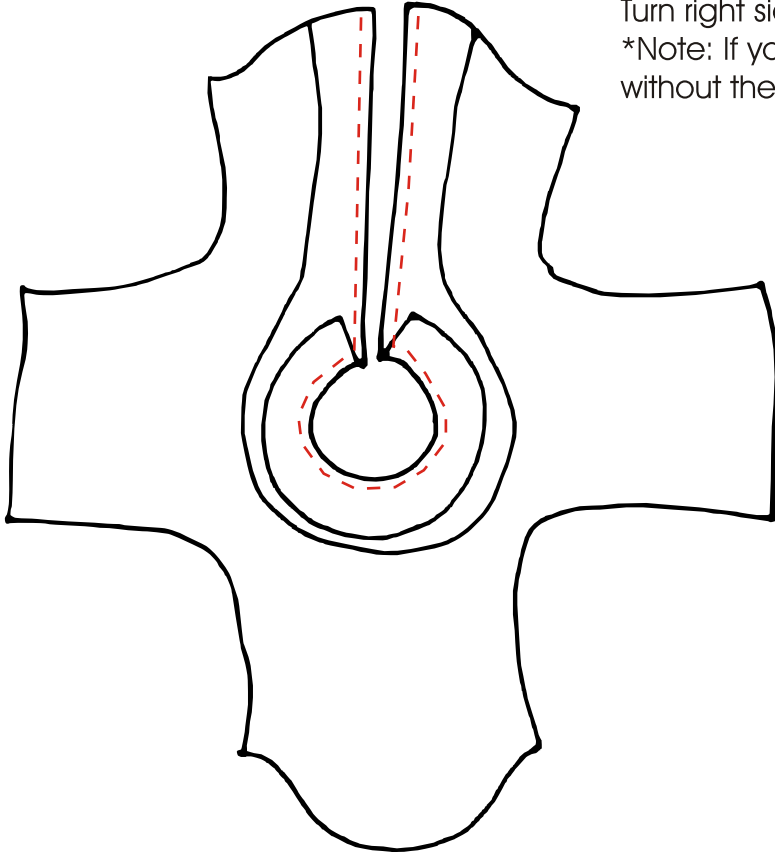
# Shirt Instructions



Hem sleeves...ok, you're done with the easy part!  
Fold collar in half with right sides together, and stitch up the two short sides. Turn right side out and press.



Here comes the fun part...  
With right sides together, sandwich the collar between the shirt body and the interfacing.



Baste in place, then  
stitch up one side, around the neck and down the other side.  
Turn right side out and press.  
\*Note: If you are not using the collar, simply do the same thing,  
without the collar in between the layers. No basting needed.

With right sides together, fold the front over and stitch along the sleeve bottom and down the side. Repeat on other side.

Press then hem the bottom hem. Add snaps on the inside and decorative buttons on the outside...done!
